Pam's work is in numerous private and public collections including Royal Bank of Scotland, University of Liverpool, Baillie Gifford and Cameron House and is popular with art lovers, investors and serious collectors alike. She travels widely across Scotland in search of viewpoints to paint.

"My main inspiration is in the Scottish land and seascape," says Pam. "I enjoy using colour to define contours, structure and changing light sequences. I am equally inspired by the rugged isolation of the Western Isles and the dramatic viewpoints of the Eastern coastline."

The Scottish Seascapes of Pam Carter exhibition is an unprecedented chance to enjoy the work of one of Scotland's foremost living artists in Buckingham. Pam's work is being displayed on the ground floor of the gallery. Meanwhile, the upstairs gallery will feature a mix of work from a variety of leading contemporary artists including Sue Moffitt, Theo Booth, Iain Carby, Trevor Price and Mychael Barratt.
